TERMS OF USE

Research-Use Only License Agreement: My Science Tutor Children's Conversational Speech Corpus

Definitions

Corpus—MyST Children's Conversational Speech Corpus, or any part thereof (Corpus). Licensee will receive one downloadable file containing speech and text files.

Terms

- Grant of License: Subject to the terms and conditions of this license, Licensor grants to Licensee a non-exclusive, non-sub licensable, non-transferable license to use the Corpus provided herein and any associated documentation. Licensee may not sell, gift, or distribute the Corpus, or any derivative of the Corpus in any form or manner except that Licensee may include limited excerpts from the Corpus in articles, reports and other documents describing the results of research projects.
- 2. Licensee's education, research and non-commercial technology development. Licensor is not obligated to provide upgrades to the Corpus or technical support.
- 3. Ownership of Corpus: The Corpus is the property of Boulder Learning Inc. and is protected by applicable copyright law. In no event shall Licensee publish, retransmit, display, redistribute, or otherwise reproduce any or all of the Corpus in any format to anyone, except as allowed in Section 1 of this Agreement. This License is not a sale of the Corpus and Licensor retains all title to all rights and interests in the Corpus.
- 4. **Permitted Uses**: Licensee may use the Corpus for linguistic education, research, and non-commercial technology development. Licensee may make copies of the Corpus as reasonably necessary for internal licensed use.
- 5. Non-permitted Uses: Licensee may not: (a) use the Corpus at any other location(s) than as specified above; (b) directly or indirectly sell, rent, lease, donate, transmit, retransmit, broadcast, or otherwise distribute the Corpus or any part thereof or derived therefrom in any form or by any means to any third party, except that User may include limited excerpts from the Corpus in articles, reports and other documents describing the results of Licensee's educational, research and non-commercial technology development; (c) make the Corpus or any part thereof available for any other use by loan, rental, service bureau, timesharing or similar arrangement; (d) incorporate the Corpus, or any part of the corpus, into any other product or service distributed externally by Licensee in any format, in whole or in part; (e) remove, modify, alter or obscure the copyright notices or any other proprietary notices contained in or on the Corpus. Derivative work means work based upon the Corpus where the Corpus has been recast, transformed, adapted or revised for creating or permitting third parties to create derivative works based on the Corpus. Licensee agrees that the Corpus shall not be used as the basis of a commercial product or service or otherwise adapted to circumvent the need for obtaining a license from BLI (if one is then available) for the use of the Corpus other than as specified by this Agreement.

- 6. **Term and Termination:** This License shall commence on the date of delivery of the Corpus to Licensee and shall terminate automatically upon breach of this License by Licensee. Upon termination, Licensee shall discontinue all use of Corpus and return to BLI or destroy original and all copies of the Corpus within 15 days of termination.
- 7. Licensor warrants that it has the lawful right to grant the license set forth in this Agreement.
- 8. EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN SECTION 7, THE PARTIES ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT Licensor, its Trustees, Directors, Officers, Employees, and Affiliates make no representations and extend no warranties of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, non-infringement and the absence of latent or other defects, whether or not discoverable. Nothing in the License Agreement shall be construed as a representation made or warranty given by Licensor that the practice by Licensee of the license granted hereunder shall not infringe the patent rights or copyright rights of any third party.
